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ORDER:-

The State Government of Andhra Pradesh desires to waive the agricultural crop loans given to the farmers, women Self Help Groups and handloom and power-loom weavers. To examine in detail the implications and to suggest the modalities and methodology of implementation of this Scheme, it is decided to constitute an Expert Committee.

- 3. The terms of reference for the Expert Committee on loan waiver scheme are,
 - To formulate an appropriate proposal to implement the crop loan waiver and waiver of loans to women's Self Help Groups (SHG).
 - 2. To examine and quantify gold loans taken for cropping purpose by women.
 - 3. To work out the methodology to implement the proposed scheme with adequate checks and balances to ensure that the benefit goes to all the deserving farmers and SHG groups.

- 4. To suggest ways and means to ensure that the resource outflow from Government augments agricultural activity in the State and ameliorates the condition of financially distressed farmers.
- 5. To explore and recommend ways and means to raise the required resources for implementation of the above proposal.
- 6. To recommend a systemic framework for effective implementation of the proposed scheme transparently with built in accountability.
- To study the interest subvention scheme by Government of India and explore the possibility of utilizing the scheme benefits optimally for the proposed scheme.
- 8. To interact whenever necessary with any State Government Department, Banks, Reserve Bank of India, Government of India etc on behalf of the State Government.
- 9. To examine and suggest recommendations for issues incidental thereto.
- 4. The Expert Committee shall give its interim recommendations within two weeks from the date of its constitution, to facilitate kharif loan disbursal as per schedule. The final report of the Committee shall be furnished in 45 days.
