Supply of Fertilizers

Nutrient Based Subsidy Policy (NBS Policy):

Department of Fertilizers (DoF), Government of India communicated the New Nutrient Based Subsidy Policy effective from 1.4.2010 and continued in the year 2022-23 also.

Salient features of NBS Policy:

- Products covered: The NBS is applicable to DAP, MOP, MAP, TSP, 15 grades of Complex fertilizers, Ammonium Sulphate (of GSFC & FACT) and SSP.
- Subsidy Applicable: The primary nutrients of N, P,K and Sulphur (S) are eligible for subsidy. (The per Kg subsidy N- Rs. 98.02/-., P-Rs. 66.93 /-, K- Rs. 23.65 /-, S- Rs. 6.12 /-) for the year 2022-23 (from 1st Oct'22 upto 31st Mar'2023) under NBS Scheme.
- Additional per Tonne subsidy is given for fertilizers carrying other secondary and micro nutrients. This is to encourage balanced use of fertilizers. The per MT additional subsidy on Boron (B) Rs. 300/- & Zinc (Zn)- Rs. 500/-.
 Secondary Nutrients: Calcium (Ca) & Sulphur (S)
 Micro Nutrients: ZincNutrients:(Zn),Boron (B),Manganese,(Mn),Iron(Fe),Copper(Cu) & Molybdenum (Mo)
- *The Department of Fertilizers (DoF) fixes the subsidy of fertilizers and the companies will decide the MRPs.
- *Printing on the Bags: The fertilizer companies required to print the Maximum Retail Prices (MRP) along with the applicable subsidy on the fertilizer bags clearly. Any sale above the printed MRP will be punishable under Essential Commodities Act.
- *All the Fertilizer Inspectors will ensure compliance of the above item.
- *The distribution and movement of fertilizers along with import of finished fertilizers, fertilizer inputs and production by indigenous units will continue to be monitored through the online web based "Integrated Fertilizer Monitoring System (iFMS)".
- Manufacturers / Marketers / Importers of P&K fertilizers, including manufacturers of SSP, are required to ensure that fertilizers are transported up to the retail point on Freight on Road (F.O.R.) delivery basis.
- There would be no separate subsidy on sale of customized fertilizers and Mixture Fertilizers.

• The Payment of subsidy to the manufacturers / Importers of P&K fertilizers shall be released as per the procedure and terms & Conditions mentioned in the Department Notification No.D(FA)/ CCEA / 2011 dated 25.10.2012 and D(FA)/2016/DBT dated 17.03.2017, as amended from time to time.

Supply Plan of Fertilizers: -

The product-wise monthly allocations to the States i.e., supply plans will be decided and communicated to the States by the Department of Fertilizers (DoF), Government of India and in turn to the districts from the State head Office as being done now.

DBT

Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Division:

The Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Division is headed by Additional Secretary who is assisted by a Director (DBT). The work entrusted to Direct Benefit Transfer Division is implementation of DBT in Fertilizers; all DBT related activities in the country, Coordination with NIC, Administration of DBT PMU/State & District Coordinators, iFMS related activities etc.

The Government has introduced Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) system for fertilizer subsidy payments. Under the fertilizer DBT system, 100% subsidy on various fertilizer grades shall be released to the fertilizer companies, on the basis of actual sales made by the retailers to the beneficiaries. Sale of all subsidized fertilizers to farmers/buyers will be made through Point of Sale (PoS) devices installed at each retailer shop and the beneficiaries will be identified through Aadhaar Card, KCC, Voter Identity Card etc.

Salient features of DBT in Fertilizer:

- The DBT model in fertilizers is different from the conventional system of DBT being implemented in LPG.
- Under DBT system in fertilizer subsidies, the farmers/beneficiaries will continue to receive Urea at statutory subsidised prices and P&K fertilizers at subsidized prices in the market.
- The fertilizer companies, which used to receive subsidy on receipt of fertilizers at the district, will now get subsidy after the retailers sell the fertilizers to farmers/beneficiaries through Point of Sale (PoS) machines through biometric authentication.

Dr. YSR RBKs - A Game Changer in Fertilizer Supplies at Panchayat Level

- ➤ The Govt of A.P with the vision of doubling of farmers income through various initiatives have established 10,778 Government owned and Government operated Rythu Bharosa Kendras (RBKs) at all the village secretariats across the State.
- The Rythu Bharosa Kendra (RBK)is a common platform to integrate different line functions and is highly necessitated to excel and accelerate Government services qualitatively and quantitatively. Further, RBK is a most novel, effective and efficient platform for knowledge dissemination &assimilation and also to provide farmers with pre-tested & certified quality assured inputs and allied services.
- ➤ Integrated holistic approach of Seed to Sale Concept is being adopted for sustainability of RBKs in extending services to the farmers viz., supply of pretested quality assured Agri-inputs, technology transfer & procurement of produce etc.

- > Supply of Fertilizers across the table by pre-positioning of the fertilizers at RBK Godowns in the Villages duly adopting the DBT guidelines using iFMS android 3.1.
- > Each RBK is provided with a digital kiosk through which the agri inputs will be indented by the farmers assisted by Village Agricultural Assistant (VAA).
- ➤ In each Gram Panchayat, a village volunteer is attached to the VAA to assist in input sale transactions.
- > To reduce the cost on logistics, Retail Fertilizer Licenses were issued to all the RBKs to get Fertilizer stocks on FOL.
- > Facilitated the Integrated Laboratory Services for quality testing of various Agri inputs. To facilitate the farmers to access quality fertilizers in the villages, the fertilizers are made available to the farmers at RBKs.
- > Already fertilizers are being supplied to the RBKs without any brand preference, Hence they are being identified as brand neutral input stores.

Impact of RBKs in Fertilizer Sales;

- · Supply of Pre-tested, certified, Quality Assured Inputs at farmer's doorsteps.
- Pre-tested quality input supply and technology transfer twin objectives.
- · Stabilization of Market Operated Prices
- · Avoiding linkage of products
- Supply at fair prices at farmer doorsteps.
- No hoarding, price escalation and panic situation.
- Saving of cost towards logistics / transport.
- Brand neutral outlets / farmer preferred brands
